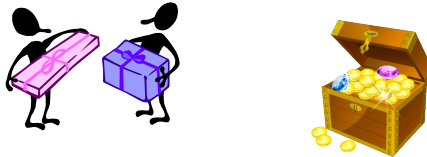


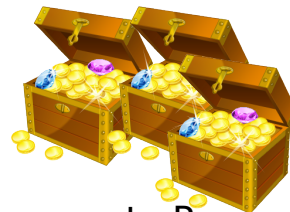
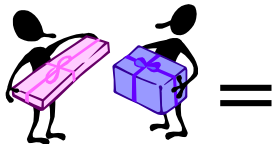
What is a Compliment ?

1. Saying something **NICE about** someone
2. Saying something **NICE** directly **to** the person

When you say something nice **about** a person, **to** that person, he or she will probably feel good. This is why we say, **giving** a compliment is like **giving** a gift.



Gifts and **Compliments** provide **value** and make people **feel good**.
