

Ending a Conversation



1. Keep showing a good **Listening Position**



2. Wait for 2 seconds after a pause before talking. **Don't interrupt.**



3. Ask **one more Follow Up Question** or say **one more On-topic Comment**

4. Say: **“I have to go.
See you later.
Bye.”**



Different ways to say, “Bye” and End a Conversation

Some ways let your friend know that you mean more than simply, *Bye*...but that you enjoy your friendship, that you look forward to seeing them again, etc.



“Adios”	“See you later – Bye”	“Goodbye”
“I have to go - Bye.”	“Adios amigos.”	“That was fun. See you tomorrow.”
“I’m going to miss you man. Goodbyes are so hard.”	“Catch you tomorrow – Bye.”	“I have to go. See you later. Bye.”
