Asking:

1. Get your friends attention (Say his/her name and/or tap on shoulder).

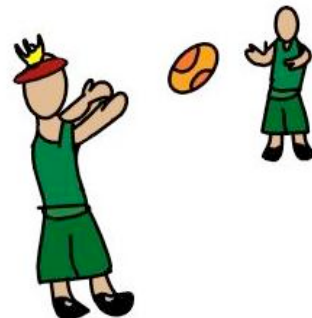
2. **Hold out** your **hand**.
